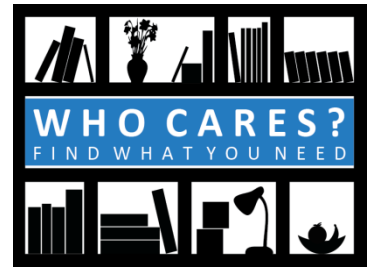

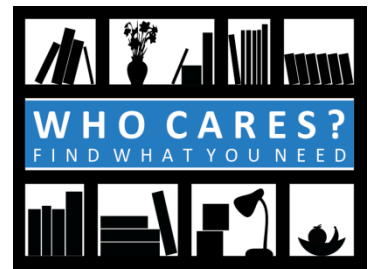

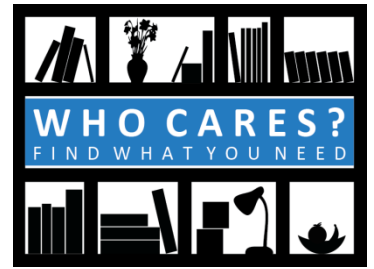

Sarcoma UK is represented on national, local and European initiatives working to improve standards of treatment and care.

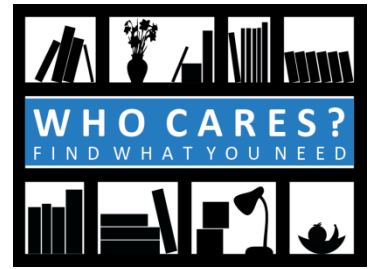
Sarcoma UK is active in the policy and campaigning world representing the experiences of sarcoma patients and lobbying for more awareness and improved standards of care.

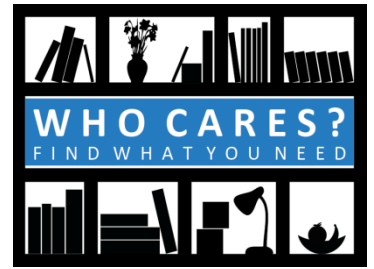

Melanoma UK is a patient support and advocacy group, dedicated to helping skin cancer patients during all stages and fundraising to provide melanoma nurses and research.

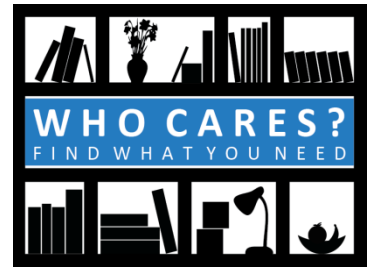

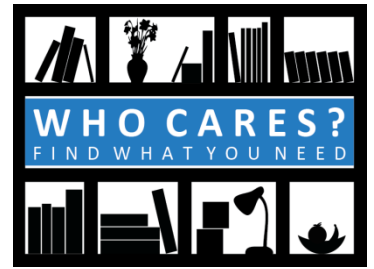

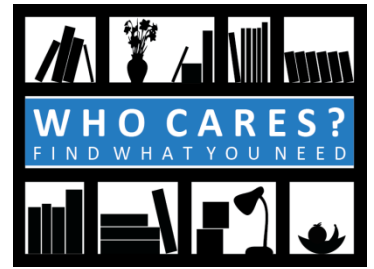
